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CHARACTERS

THE MOUSE — a new friend in the pool of tears who would rather not hear of cats

DUCK, DODO, LORY, EAGLET, CRAB, MAGPIE, CANARY — animals caught in the pool of tears

BILL — a poor fellow who is sent down — and kicked out of — a chimney

THE CATERPILLAR — a three-inch mushroom-sitter who gives advice

FISH-FOOTMAN — a footman for the Queen

FROG-FOOTMAN — a footman for the Duchess

THE DUCHESS — a rather rude woman who is fond of morals

THE CHESHIRE CAT — the Duchess's grinning cat who tends to disappear

CHARACTERS

THE COOK — the Duchess's cook who makes pepper soup

THE MARCH HARE — the host of a tea party outside his house

THE MAD HATTER — an odd tea party guest who does not do well with keeping Time

DORMOUSE — a sleepy guest at the tea party

TWO, SEVEN AND FIVE — three royal gardeners who are truly cards

THE QUEEN OF HEARTS — the ruler of the croquet game (and everyone's head)

THE KING OF HEARTS — the Queen's patient and rather dull husband

THE KNAVE OF HEARTS — a royal servant who may have stolen some tarts

THE GRYPHON — a droll creature who introduces Alice to the Mock Turtle

THE MOCK TURTLE — a very sad and tearful teller of tales
